4. GENERAL COMMENTARY ON TRAILS COMMITTEE PRIORITIES, PLANS, AND STRATEGIES

The Trails Committee will discuss the state of trails and trail connectivity in the City and strategize ways to achieve desired goals that need to be addressed by the City Council and Planning Commission. The Committee may formulate a list of specific priority projects.

5. LAGUNA CREEK TRAIL NEAR THE BOND ROAD/WATERMAN ROAD INTERSECTION

Public Works staff will provide an update on expansion of the Bond Road and Waterman Road bridges. The Trails Committee will discuss implementation strategies for trail construction along Laguna Creek below these two bridges.

6. UPDATE ON TRAILS AT TWO LOCATIONS

The Committee will be provided an update on trails planning through the following two properties and may make recommendations concerning trails at those locations:

- Southeast corner of the Calvine Road/Waterman Road intersection. A trail is proposed through the powerline corridor; and
- Northeast of the Market Place 99 project on Bond Road. A trail is proposed to connect Camden Passage and the commercial uses to the south.

7. STATUS ON REQUEST TO ADOPT CITY TRAILS MAP

Staff will provide an update on the Trails Committee's request that the City Council approach the Elk Grove Community Services District (EGCSD) concerning adoption of the Elk Grove General Plan City Trails Map to ensure implementation of trails not currently part of a comprehensive trails system in Elk Grove.

8. BICYCLE TOUR OF CITY OF DAVIS BICYCLING FACILITIES ON OCTOBER 23, 2004

The Committee will review the itinerary and finalize plans for the upcoming bicycle tour of Davis to be hosted by the City of Davis Bicycle Coordinator.

The Trails Committee will provide direction to staff for future agenda items.
