3. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Approval of the action minutes of the October 18, 2004 regular meeting.

4. PROJECT REVIEW AND UPDATE

The Trails Committee will be provided with site plans for the projects listed below and may make recommendations concerning trails at those locations:

- Elk Grove Boulevard Development (EG-03-488; located at the southeast corner of the Elk Grove Boulevard/Webb Street intersection. Mel Pabalinas is the Project Planner.)
- Crabb Property (EG-03-524; located at the southwest corner of Elk Grove Boulevard/Waterman Road intersection. Stuart Wagner is the Project Planner.)
- Saca Bond Road (EG-04-462; located north of Bond Road between the Market Place 99 commercial development and California Fitness. Jessica Shalamunec is the Project Planner.)
- Thompson Rezone (EG-04-711; located on Sheldon Road between Waterman Road and Bradshaw Road and near Laguna Creek Tributary 1. Stuart Wagner is the Project Planner.)

5. UPDATE ON THE LEWIS STEIN ROAD PROJECT

Public Works staff will provide an update on the proposed project, which consists of construction of a two-lane roadway from Big Horn Boulevard to the existing intersection of West Stockton Boulevard/Lewis Stein Road and median improvements to the existing portion of Lewis Stein Road. The project includes construction of a 140-foot long bridge over Laguna Creek and a 187-foot long bridge over Laguna Creek Bypass Channel. The Trails Committee may comment on trail design in the project vicinity.

6. ADDITIONAL DISCUSSION ON THE BOND ROAD WIDENING PROJECT AND THE BOND ROAD AND WATERMAN ROAD BRIDGE EXPANSION PROJECTS

Public Works staff will present additional information concerning trail access under and across the new bridges located near the Bond Road/Waterman Road intersection.

7. TRAILS PLANNING IN THE AREA BETWEEN WATERMAN ROAD, JORDAN RANCH ROAD, CALVINE ROAD, AND SHELDON ROAD

Landowners in this area would like to be able to use the land on the east side of Laguna Creek between the creek and the existing maintenance road; and then dedicate the land between the creek and Waterman Road to the City. A trail is currently proposed to be located on the east side of the creek. The landowners are asking whether the trail could be moved to the west side. The Trails Committee will discuss this proposal.

8. PROVISION OF TRAIL SIGNAGE

The Committee will discuss provision of trail signage and options the Committee has to encourage the placement of additional signs.

9. DISCUSSION ON EFFORTS TO COMPLETE THE TRAIL SYSTEM

The Committee will discuss ways that the Trails Committee can assist EGCS and City efforts to complete the trail system.

10. BICYCLE TOUR FOLLOW-UP

Staff will provide a summary of the October 23, 2004 bicycle tour of City of Davis bicycle facilities hosted by the City Bicycle Coordinator. Photos of the various facilities will be provided.
