Application Title:	Jones Family Park Metro PCS Monopine Conditional Use Permit

Property Address/Location:	8840 Shasta Lily Drive, Elk Grove, CA. 95624
Project Description:	Applicant requesting a Conditional Use Permit to install, operate, and maintain a 70' tall monopine design tower with 15' x 25' lease area. The lease area will be located near the parks northeast corner. Kyra O'Malley is the project planner.

Application Title: New Parish Catholic Church
Assessor's Parcel Number: 121-0220-008
Property Address/Location: 8800 Bradshaw Road; The project site is located on the west side of Bradshaw Rd, approximately 200 yards north of the intersection of Bradshaw Rd and Sheldon Rd.
Project Description: The project consists of a Conditional Use Permit and Design Review to construct and operate a Catholic Parish in the AR-5 zone. The project is proposed to be constructed in 3 phases: Phase 1) a 600 seat building and a 4 bedroom Rectory along with associated parking and landscaping; Phase 2) 1-story K-8 elementary school along with playfields; Phase 3) final build-out of main church (1200 seats total) and additional parking. Sarah Kirchgessner is the project planner.
