Application Title: Sheldon Road Parcel Map

Property Address/Location: 10259 Sheldon Road
Project Description: The applicant is requesting for a four lot tentative parcel map to be consistent with the current zoning of 2 acre minimum within the rural residential area. Kyra O'Malley is the project planner.

Application Title: Stonebridge Rezone and Tentative Subdivision Map
Assessor's Parcel Number: 127-0010-077
Property Address/ Location: 9350 Sheldon Road
Project Description: This is a revised submittal. The applicant has responded to agency comments both on the map and in writing and has included proposed subdivision of both east and west halves of the site. Summary information is attached. The applicant is proposing to rezone the site from AG-80 to AR-2. The applicant

proposes to subdivide both sides of the property and leave an open space lot along Laguna Creek. According to the proposed tentative map, the project features a total of 30 single-family sites. Christopher Jordan is the project planner.

- D. 2008 City of Elk Grove Greenprint Program Tree Plantings – John Smoley, Planning, will brief the Committee on eight native oak tree plantings along Elk Grove trails scheduled to take place during 2008.
- E. Calvine-99 Special Planning Area Trail Location Planning Session – John Smoley, Planning, will brief the Committee on subdivision construction history within the Calvine-99 planned trail corridor and request input from the Trails Committee on the desired location of the planned north-south trail running along Auberry Drive from Sheldon Road to Monterey Trail High School in the Calvine-99 Special Planning Area.
- F. Circulation Element General Plan Amendment - Gary Grunwald, Public Works, will brief the Committee on the Circulation Element General Plan Amendment approved by City Council on January 23, 2008 which amended figure CI-2 of the General Plan Circulation Element to indicate a future interchange at Whitelock Parkway and Highway 99, the planned location of a trail crossing over Highway 99.
