The City of Elk Grove is now accepting applications for the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and Community Service Grant (CSG) programs for the 2012-13 Fiscal Year. Nonprofit organizations and local governmental entities serving Elk Grove residents may apply for funding for service provision and/or facility improvements. The City will consider all applications for grant funding and determine which proposed activities meet either grant's eligibility criteria. If you are interested in submitting an application, you must complete the application form (available on the City's website at <http://www.egplanning.org/housing/cdbg.asp>), and submit it with all the required documentation by **February 24, 2012 at 5:00pm**.

Only complete applications submitted for eligible activities in accordance with the required format and instructions will be considered for funding. If you are considering submitting an application for funding and have not previously received CDBG or CSG funding, please contact Sarah Bontrager at (916) 627-3209 for assistance in determining activity eligibility.

The City will hold a technical assistance workshop and public meeting to assist applicants and provide members of the public an opportunity to share what types of activities they feel are most needed in Elk Grove.
